



Council Highlights – September 19, 2025

Below is a summary of key decisions taken by Council at its meeting held by MS Teams and available to the public on GoToWebinar on September 19, 2025.

Policy 2.15, Committee and Panel Chairs - Terms of Reference

After a brief presentation from Julie Maciura, SML Law, Council approved Policy 2.15 – Committee and Panel Chairs Terms of Reference. This policy addresses a gap in governance tools by outlining the role of Chairs of statutory committees (other than the Executive Committee) and panels. Recognizing the growth in the regulatory work of these committees and that it is in the public interest to have a wider pool of candidates the Council passed a motion stipulating that these roles may be filled by any member of said Committee, including Non-Council Committee Members.

Finance and investment reports

Council received and approved the Finance and Audit Committee Report, the Q2 2025 Financial Report, and the Q2 2025 Investment Report.

Policy review

Registrar & CEO, Pree Tyagi, lead Council through its regular policy review. Council approved the following policies with no amendments:

- Policy 0.1, Policy Register and Review Policy - pages 67 – 78
- Policy 1.1., Customer Service Accessibility Policy - pages 79 – 84
- Policy 1.4, Policy and Program regarding workplace harassment - pages 85 – 96
- Policy 1.5, Policy and Program regarding violence in the workplace

In addition, Council reviewed and approved proposed amendments to Policy 8.2, Publication of Discipline Decisions, which will see the College begin to post Discipline Committee decisions to the Canadian Legal Information Institute (CanLII).


Reporting

David Wright, Chair of the Health Professions Discipline Tribunals presented to Council on the HPDT, an emerging model for health regulatory colleges to share resources and processes for their discipline tribunals.
