



Council Highlights – September 15, 2023

Below is a summary of key decisions and highlights of the Council meeting held by MS Teams and available to the public on GoToWebinar on September 15, 2023.

Finance and investment reports

Council received and approved the financial and investment reports from the Finance and Audit Committee for the second quarter ending June 30, 2023.

Policy review

CMRITO regularly reviews all policies to ensure the policies remain current and reflect the College's organizational values. Council approved amendments and revocations to CMRITO policies as presented by Professional Conduct & Regulatory Affairs Director Elizabeth Urso.

By-law amendments

CMRITO General Counsel Tina Langlois led Council through proposed amendments to CMRITO By-law No. 60. These changes include emergency class fee exemptions and terminology enhancements to better reflect the regulatory role of the College. Council approved the proposed amendments for circulation to members and stakeholders for a period of 60 days.

Registrar & CEO's report

Registrar & CEO Pree Tyagi presented the Registrar's Report to Council. This report included updates about correspondence with the Minister of Health regarding the emergency class of registration, federal initiatives to draw internationally trained health workers to Canada, professional liability insurance sources in Ontario, and CMRITO's draft Land Acknowledgement.

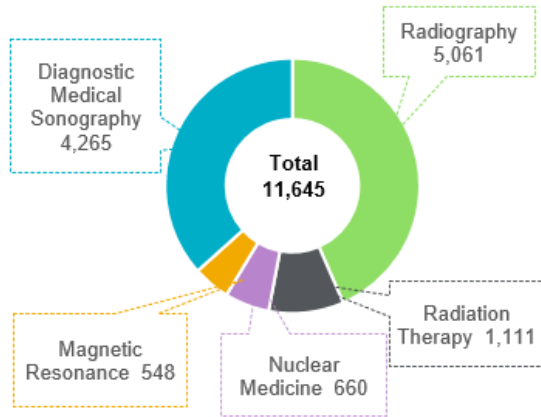

Strategic Plan & Operational reports

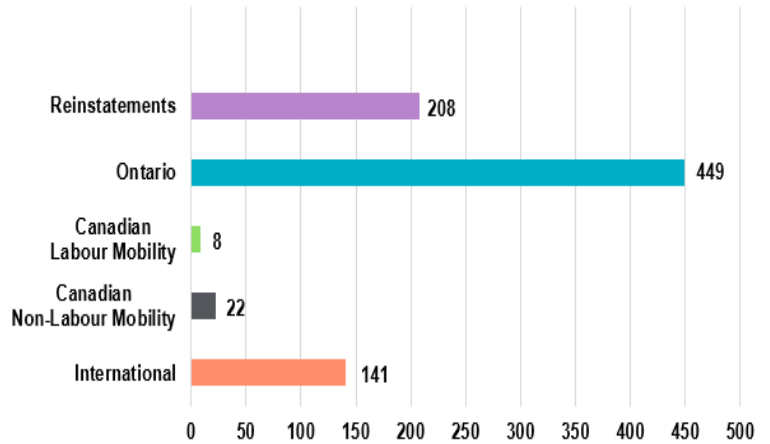

Council received and approved the CMRTO Balanced Scorecard Report for 2023 Q2. The 2023 Q2 Dashboard is available on the CMRITO website.

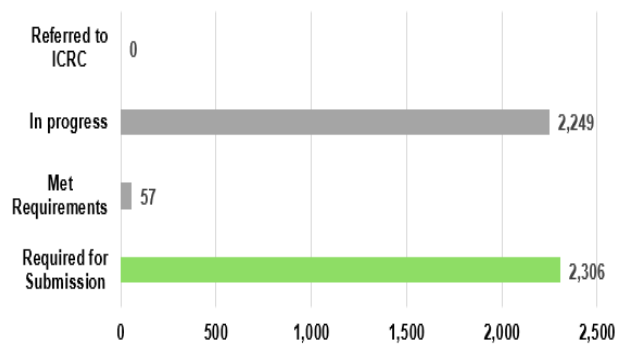
Active members by primary specialty



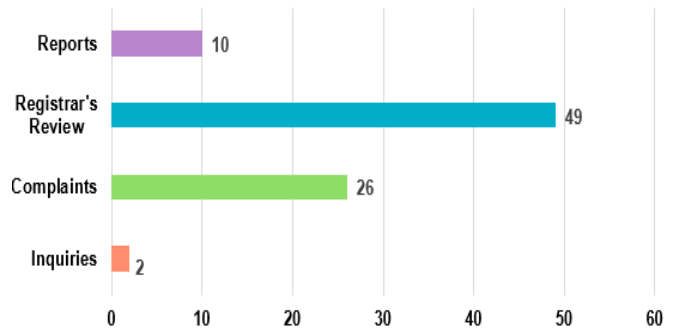
Registration Applications
