Explanatory note regarding the public register

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The CMRITO's register of members contains information about members, some of which is available to the public. The public register allows the public to view certain information about current and past members on the CMRITO website. Individuals can search for information about medical radiation and imaging technologists using first or last names, names used in practice and the names of facilities where members practise or by CMRITO registration numbers.

Public register information

This section of the public register shows the following information about a member:

- last name
- given name (s)
- name used in practice (if applicable)
- registration number
- registration status
- class of registration
- specialty(ies)
- business address and business telephone number for a member's primary and any other places of practice

"Registration status" shows the status of current and past members. There are five types of registration status: active member, suspended, suspended – failure to pay fees, revoked and resigned.

- Active member - the registration status of a current member. Only individuals who have "active member" status are legally able to practise the profession in Ontario.
- Suspended, suspended for failure to pay fees, or revoked - the registration status of a person whose certificate of registration is suspended, suspended because they failed to pay their fees or is revoked respectively. These individuals are no longer members and cannot practise the profession in Ontario.
- Resigned - the registration status of a person who has resigned. This person is no longer a member and cannot practice the profession in Ontario.

Certificate of registration – detailed history since September 1, 2013

This section contains the date(s) relevant to a member's certificate of registration including the date the certificate was first issued and the dates the member was active, resigned, suspended or revoked, as applicable.

Detailed specialty history since September 1, 2013

This section shows the registration history for each specialty certificate of registration which a member holds or has held, including changes to the registration status of each specialty, since September 1, 2013. A member's registration history prior to September 1, 2013 may also be indicated but only if the information was available to the CMRITO as of September 1, 2013.

Registrations in other jurisdictions

This section contains information that a member has provided about any current registrations in other jurisdiction(s) in which they are registered to practise as a medical radiation and imaging technologist in any of the specialties, or another health profession in Canada or another country and the dates of the registration.

Terms, conditions and limitations:

This section contains any terms, conditions and limitations that are in effect on a certificate of registration. Every member of CMRITO has a term, condition and limitation on their certificate of registration that they shall practice only in the areas of medical radiation and imaging technology in which they are educated and experienced.

Current referrals

This section contains information regarding any matter that has been referred to the Discipline Committee and is still outstanding. The information includes the date of referral, a summary of

the allegations, the date of the hearing, if set, the next scheduled date for continuation of the hearing, if the hearing was adjourned, and the place of the hearing.

Special notices

This section contains information such as:

- a notice of a suspension for failure to pay fees
- a notice when the suspension penalty and fees have been paid and the member has reinstated
- any information that the CMRITO and the member have agreed should be included
- findings of professional negligence or malpractice made against the member unless the finding is reversed on appeal
- a notation of any caution a member has received from a panel of the Inquiries, Complaints and Reports (ICR) Committee and any specified continuing education or remedial programs required by a panel of the ICR Committee
- a notation and synopsis of any Acknowledgment and Undertaking (A & U) that a member has entered into with the CMRITO that is still in effect
- a notation of a member's resignation and agreement to never practise again in Ontario signed by the member during or as a result of an investigation
- a notation where a member has agreed to resign to avoid a proceeding of the Discipline Committee or has resigned while a discipline proceeding was outstanding
- a summary of any existing restriction on a member's right to practise that was imposed by a court or other lawful authority (if the CMRITO is aware of the restriction)
- a brief summary of a finding of guilt and the sentence against a member made under the Criminal Code (Canada) or the *Controlled Drugs and Substances Act (Canada)*, and, if the finding is under appeal, a notation that it is under appeal until a decision on the appeal is made
- a notation of any currently existing conditions of release following a charge for an offence or a finding of guilt under the Criminal Code (Canada) or the *Controlled Drugs and Substances Act (Canada)* and any pending appeals or variations to those conditions of release
- a notation of the content and the date and place of the charge if a member has an outstanding charge of an offence under the Criminal Code (Canada) or the *Controlled Drugs and Substances Act (Canada)*.

Findings

This section contains information regarding the result of a discipline or fitness to practise proceeding (the finding, the grounds for the finding, the order made and a synopsis of the decision). It also contains a notation if a finding has been appealed.

Professional health corporation

This section contains information regarding the name of any health profession corporation of which the member is a shareholder.

When information is not available

There are limited circumstances under which the above information about a member may not be available on the public register. For example, information may not be available on the public register if the Registrar has reasonable grounds to believe that disclosure of the information may jeopardize the safety of an individual.
