Purpose

It is a requirement for registration with CMRITO that an applicant must successfully complete the examination set or approved by Council in one or more of the specialties.

The purpose of this Policy is to facilitate the more efficient registration of certain applicants by providing them with access to approved examinations without a referral to the Registration Committee.

For clarity, this Policy does not prevent the Registration Committee from considering providing access to approved examinations to applicants who do not meet all of the requirements below, which would be done through a referral to the Registration Committee.

Application

This Policy applies only to applicants who:

- have successfully completed an educational program in one of the five specialties that is either listed in Ontario Regulation 31/24 made under the *Medical Radiation and Imaging Technology Act, 2017* or approved by Council as equivalent to a program that is listed,
- have competently practised in that same specialty outside Ontario in the last five years, and
- meet all requirements for registration with exception of having successfully completed the examination set or approved by Council in the relevant specialty.

Policy

An applicant described above will be provided with access to the examination in their speciality without the need to refer their application to the Registration Committee.
