LEGISLATIVE REQUIREMENT:

(Section 10(2) of Regulation 866/93 made under the Medical Radiation Technology Act)

Where a member ceases to practice in Ontario, the Registrar may re-register the member as a medical radiation technologist if the member,

- (a) had provided the Registrar with a resignation in writing during the registration year in which such member ceased to practise;
- (b) submits proof, in a form that is satisfactory to the Registration Committee, of competence as a medical radiation technologist in one or more of the specialties in the year in which such person wishes to resume practice in Ontario and, if such person has not engaged in competent practice in Ontario for a period of five consecutive years, satisfies the Registration Committee by examination or otherwise as to competence to practise in Ontario as a medical radiation technologist in one or more of the specialties; and
- (c) pays the applicable fees.

POLICY:

In order to provide equitable access to re-training opportunities to applicants for registration in all five specialties of medical radiation and imaging technology, the Registration Committee will apply the criteria set out in section 10(2)(b) and (c) to applicants for registration in these specialties who have completed accredited or approved educational programs, provided the

applicant also satisfies all of the other current registration requirements with the exception of
having engaged in competent practice in Ontario for a period of five consecutive years.
