### Legislative Requirements

In accordance with the Health Professions Procedural Code (the Code), being Schedule 2 to the *Regulated Health Professions Act, 1991*, if the Registrar is of the opinion that a certificate of registration should be issued to an applicant with terms, conditions and limitations (TCLs), and the applicant consents to the imposition of those TCLs, the Registrar may do so with approval of a panel of the Registration Committee that has been selected by the chair for that purpose.

### Policy

If the Registrar is of the opinion that an applicant should be issued a certificate of registration with TCLs, the applicant will be provided with written notice of that fact and be requested to consider whether they agree to the imposition of the TCLs.

If the applicant agrees, the matter will be referred to a panel of the Registration Committee (the Panel) for their review and (if appropriate) approval.

If the Panel approves, a certificate of registration will be issued to the applicant with such TCLs. In accordance with the Code, the TCLs will be posted to the public register.
